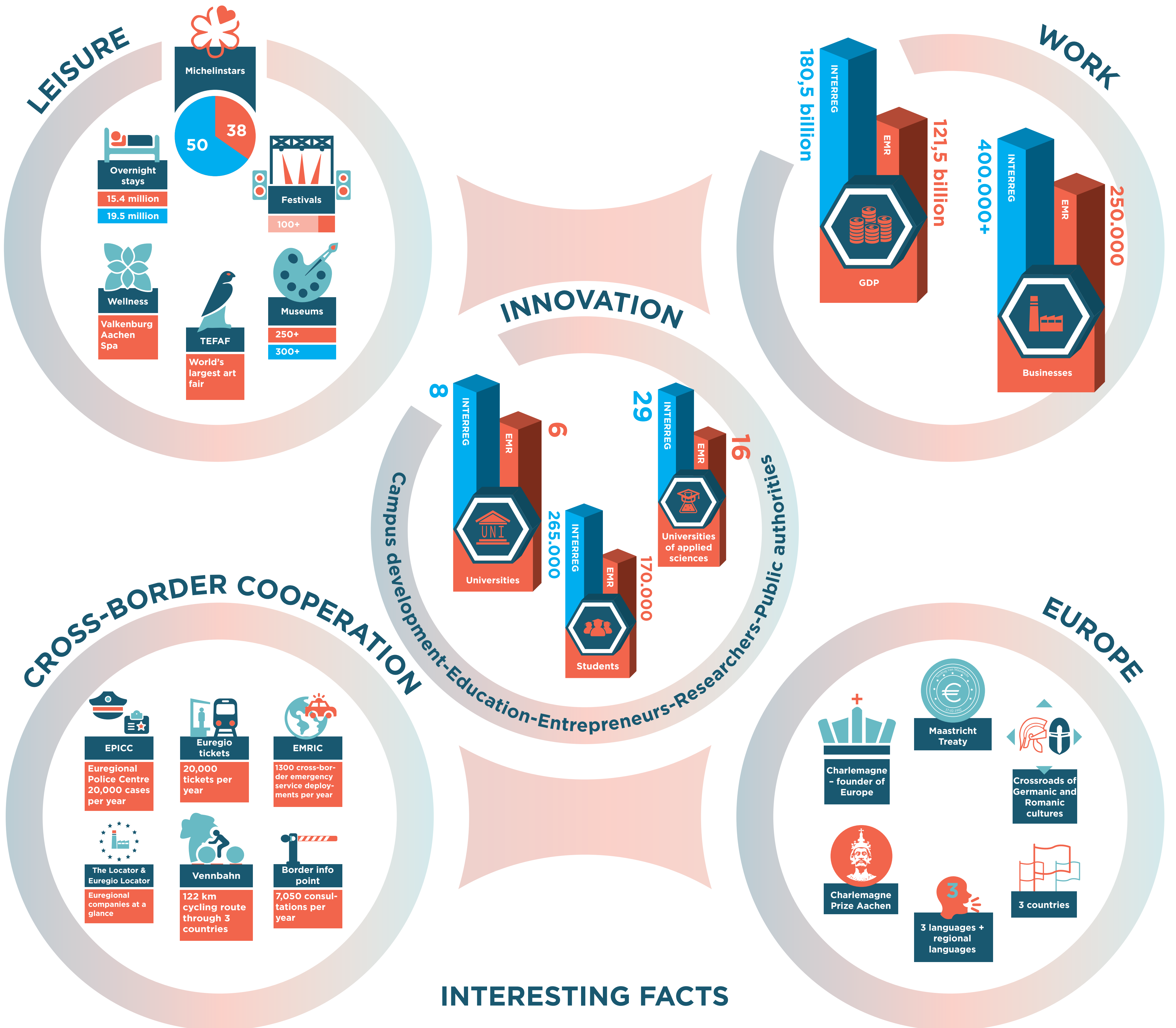

Interreg V EMR

In the period up to 2020, the Interreg V Euregio Meuse-Rhine European funding programme is investing almost 100 million euros to strengthen the cross-border cooperation in the region. The programme area consists roughly of the square between Eindhoven, Leuven, Bitburg and Cologne, including the cities of Aachen, Eupen, Hasselt, Liège and Maastricht. An area full of innovation, knowledge and culture with 5.5 million inhabitants. Via the Interreg projects, the EU invests particularly in economic development, innovation, territorial development, social inclusion and education.

The Euregio Meuse-Rhine is one of the oldest Euregions within the European Union. The partnership includes the Aachen region, the provinces of Liège, Belgian Limburg, Dutch Limburg and East Belgium with a total of 4 million inhabitants. The Euregio Meuse-Rhine focuses on multiples themes defined in the EMR2020-strategy, such as labour market, mobility, security, etc.

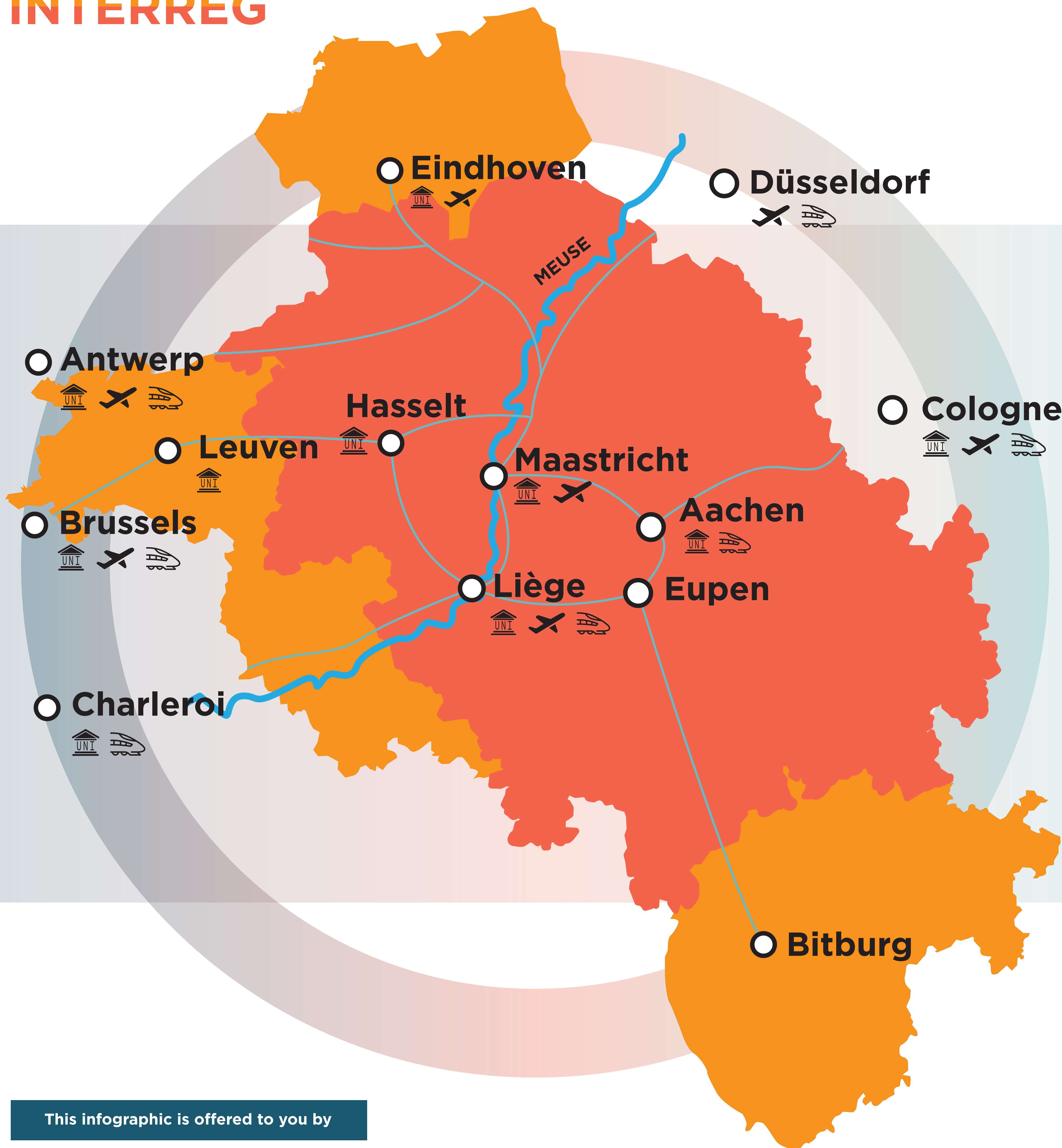
